CHURCHES CAUGHT BY SURPRISE BY COVID-19

Without debate the coronavirus pandemic or pestilence has caught the church by surprise. All the prophets, apostles and bishops had no clue their churches would be locked down.

Many had schedule of events that were disrupted.

SIMPLE BUT EFFECTIVE EVANGELISM TOOLS DURING COVID- 19

IS COVID-19 AN ENDTIME PESTILENCE

Jesus often described the End Times as being “birth pangs.” Just as labor pains grow stronger and closer together, God will allow escalation in trials of all kinds to bring men to Christ. In fact, the purpose of the Tribulation itself is to bring pressure for men to surrender to Jesus and find salvation. Jesus describes End Time events in Matthew 24, Mark 13, and Luke 21. Here’s what Jesus said in Luke 21:

“Master!” they exclaimed. “When? And will there be any warning ahead of time?” He (Jesus) replied, “Don’t let anyone mislead you. For many will come announcing themselves as the Messiah, and saying, ‘The time has come.’ But don’t believe them! And when you hear of wars and insurrections beginning, don’t panic. True, wars must come, but the end won’t follow immediately—for nation shall rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be great earthquakes, and famines in many lands, and epidemics (pestilences), and terrifying things happening in the heavens.” ESV

Why Does God Allow Coronavirus and Other Catastrophes?

The world is broken. We are sinful. Because Adam sinned, we are in mortal bodies. Death is inevitable. But we need not fear. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 15:21:

“For since [it was] by a man (Adam) that death *came* [into the world], it is also by a Man (Jesus) that the resurrection of the dead *has come*.” AMP

We live in a fallen world. If we know Christ, we can have hope and joy.

Let’s look at seven reasons God sends disease and trouble in the Bible:

1. TO ACCOMPLISH HIS PURPOSES

God used plagues to deliver the enslaved Jews from their Egyptian overlords. (Exodus 9:8-11).

God will also pour out plagues during the Tribulation to bring God-rejecters to faith in Christ. The way coronavirus spreads quickly from person to person is a foreshadowing of the way God will pronounce judgment in Revelation.

Revelation 9:15-19

“By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed, by the fire and smoke and sulfur coming out of their mouths. The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent.”

How does God accomplish His purpose in our day?

Through Jesus’ death and resurrection. Isaiah 53 tells us Christ bore our sins and diseases on the cross. We receive grace and not judgment when we believe in Him.

2. TO TEACH OBEDIENCE

Moses proclaimed the blessings of following Jehovah and the consequences of forsaking Him to teach obedience to the Israelites. In Deuteronomy 28, Moses promises children, wealth, food and safety. He warns that if Israel refuses to listen and obey, He will curse them instead.

Jesus learned obedience through the things that He suffered, and so can we!

Hebrews 5:8 ESV

“Though he were a Son, yet he learned obedience by the things which he suffered.”

3. TO OPPOSE PRIDE

God called King David “the man after God’s own heart.” But the consequences of David’s sins didn’t only impact his family. David proudly counted his army, defying God’s strict warning to humbly trust Him. So, David had three punishments from which to choose to pay for his pride: three years of famine, three months of defeat from enemies, or three days of plague. (2 Samuel 24:13).

God relents when we humble ourselves.

James 4:10

“Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God that He may exalt you.”

4. TO ABOLISH IDOLATRY

God hates idolatry (Exodus 20:3). Idolatry in our day usually revolves around money. Ezekiel 7 prophesies the destruction of the Jewish economy (buying and selling) to call His people to put away idols.

Jesus said “You cannot serve two masters: God and money. For you will hate one and love the other, or else the other way around.” (Matthew 6:24) TLB God is our provider. Jesus said God cares for sparrows and flowers. Of course He cares for us! We must trust Him and not rely on our own intellect or strength.

Time and time again, God relented when His people learned to put Him first.

5. TO TEACH GRATITUDE

The Jews complained to Moses about manna. They demanded meat. God answered their ungrateful prayers and sent them quail. He also punished them with a poisonous plague. (Numbers 11:31-33) Those who worship with thankful hearts receive God’s blessing.

Psalms 103:2-3

“Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all of His benefits, who forgives all your sins and heals your diseases.”

6. TO DEFEND HIS HOLINESS

The Philistines captured the Ark and sent it to Ashdod instead of returning it to Israel. God taught them a lesson by sending them rats and hemorrhoids! (1 Samuel 5:6).

But Jesus reconciled us to God by His death on the cross. He has made us holy:

Colossians 1:20-22

“Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you by Christ’s physical body through death to present you holy in His sight, without blemish and free from accusation.”

7. TO REVEAL HIS POWER

God permitted Satan to inflict disease upon Job so that He could reveal His majesty and power Himself to His faithful servant (Job 42).

Paul assures us that He reveals His power through our weak bodies.

2 Corinthians 4:7 TLB

“But this precious treasure—this light and power that now shine within us—is held in a perishable container, that is, in our weak bodies. Everyone can see that the glorious power within must be from God and is not our own.”

GIVING AND FINANCIAL ADVICE FOR THE CHURCHES

The following list of ideas is specifically directed to financial leaders across the church to help with sustaining the church and its ministry (and perhaps growing it in areas) as we live through these Coronavirus days.

1. The digital giving debate has heard the last word: Corona.

If you have already set up for people to give electronically to your church, you have a head start in weathering whatever the COVID-19 storm brings. If you haven't found a vendor and signed on, there is no time better than today. If you're not ready to make a commitment to embrace online giving options, consider setting up something to get you through this difficult time. PayPal, just one example, will offer charitable organizations an online donation service with a low fee of 2.2 percent and 30 cents per transaction. Some of your members may already have PayPal accounts. Also give your bank accounts on your webcast to facilitate direct transfers.

2. Give envelopes to your members or get them to make commitments by email or online.

Consider giving members offering and tithes envelopes to secure their offering and seal commitment; encourage confirmation calls and emails then send to collect. Take necessary sanitary precautions.

3. Remind members of their tithing obligation even from COVID relief.

Tithing is not optional; even in a COVID crisis.

4. Be conscious of the income impact on members.

For some of your members, the present Coronavirus crisis will not affect their incomes. Some will be offered the opportunity to work at home, which will be a savings opportunity. Not everyone, though, will be in that situation. Some will see their income seriously affected by the social distancing that is attempting to slow the spread of the disease. Things like traveling, going out to dinner, cutbacks in entertainment, reduced hours, or overtime all carry potential hardships for people who were already just getting by. Make sure your church is conveying this sensitivity in all its communications.

MEMBERS NEEDS

Older members seem more at risk. Reach out regularly.

We have been hearing through media accounts that older people are more susceptible to the COVID-19 virus. Be sure that you are taking extra care to keep in contact with older members. Just as you develop a plan for worship alternatives, a strategy for pastoral care is important in these days. This does not have to fall totally on the pastor and staff, but members who have the gifts can be recruited to call and check in on a list of older members on a regular basis. It's not hard to imagine that fear of going out to even the grocery store may put some people in need of basic food supplies. Just because other programming may be affected by the virus precautions, your church needs to continue—and maybe even strengthen—these basic caring connections through this crisis.

Consider a coronavirus assistance fund.

It's a fact. In a time of hardship, people look for a place to give. Consider offering your congregation (or the community as a whole) an opportunity to provide designated giving to a Coronavirus Assistance Fund. A scarcity mindset may tell you that people will divert money they would give to your church operating budget, but this is rarely the case. Setting up such a fund will require a meeting of your finance committee to organize the fund and set guidelines; your church council may need to approve it. Both meetings could be done by phone or video conference, if necessary. You will be impressed with the generosity of people, and you will remind your members and community that you care and are ready to be in ministry no matter what comes your way!

Send messages of hope, encouragement, and impact.

It seems clear that church life is going to be affected by this crisis. As you communicate with your congregation, be a voice of hope and encouragement – we will get through this. Knowing that one of the main reasons people give to any charitable organization is “belief in the mission,” try to celebrate in your communications that the church continues to make an impact. Tell stories of people your congregation has helped, of lives that they have nurtured and shaped by their giving.

WHAT IS THE CHURCH DOING?

One church called everyone over 70, got their grocery list, ordered and had the groceries delivered to their home. Others are specifically dropping off groceries to seniors and the immune-compromised, especially if they live alone. Some churches have taken over ministries that have been discontinued currently in their area such as meals on wheels for seniors or school lunches.

According to one church: We are used to seeing political signs in yards, but Lake Pointe Church near Dallas, Texas, has taken a different approach to signage. Lake Pointe, a large multisite church, is providing food for specific areas where food programs have been shut down, a blood drive, and other efforts. In addition to this, many of their members are putting signs in their yards. The signs say: "Self-Isolating? I can help! Contact me": With the member's name and number on the sign. This way people in their neighborhood can call them directly for help.



Some use a simple card that says, "Hello! If you are self-isolating, I can help." It allows the church member to put their name and contact information and has a list of needs the person can check. It mentions the church member will remain socially isolated and leave any items on the doorstep. Churches also use both online technology and good old-fashioned printed cards to help in their area. Championforest.org offers a place for people to ask for help and receive it. Some mentioned Facebook pages or groups are helpful in connecting with those in need locally.

Others provide care for medical and other workers in this season. [@pastortoddg](https://twitter.com/pastortoddg) notes their church provides coffee for staff at their hospital and local banks. [@NickVipperman](https://twitter.com/NickVipperman)'s church provides the ultimate: Chick-Fil-A for nurses, doctors, and medical staff. [@dan_eum](https://twitter.com/dan_eum) mentions recruiting childcare workers for healthcare workers, and Crossing Church-Chattanooga provides meals for first responders and medical workers.



Relentless Church COVID-19 OUTREACH STRATEGY: The church team leaders hand out grocery to those in need. The outreach leaders said the grocery packages were sanitized and bagged using gloves. They handed out full pizza pies, laundry detergent, canned goods and other nonperishable food items.

"This week is probably some people's last check for the foreseeable future," said Gray. "And so groceries are maybe a given to some, but not to all, so we wanted to make it not only available to our church community, but the Greenville and Upstate region to let them know that our stance is that everybody has equal value and if you have a need, we're here to provide it."

Pastor Demarcus Hill, pastor of outreach at Relentless Church, said the church works to feed about 150 to 200 people during any given week.

"They can come into our food and clothing pantry free of charge, and so today isn't a new day for us, it's just a new scheduled day. We've been doing this all along," he said. "We want to be known as a church that is able to stand where we're supposed to stand and do what we're supposed to do."

Relentless Church purchased the supplies and food donated. Church leaders Sunday were also open to accepting donations from the community.

DEVELOPING A STRONG SOCIAL MEDIA STRATEGY FOR YOUR CHURCH



The future they say is for the prepared. It's smart to think ahead. The times we live in has afforded us a tremendous opportunity to try new things and a sure way to be prepared is for the church to leverage the power of the "DIGITAL" in order to stay connected while pursuing its divine mandate. The role of technology in the modern church cannot be over emphasized, it helps churches run smoother and more efficient. Websites, podcasts, web and mobile applications and social media platforms are a few digital tools the church can leverage on in these challenging times.

The strategy

Put together a team in your church, consult a digital media expert to train them, and consider investing in your online presence as the first strategy to stay connected. Remember, the objective is to stay connected and have fellowship with your congregation virtually and an online presence does not just make this objective possible but it is also essential for growing your church and making it visible beyond the walls of your building.

The simplest, effective and most affordable strategy to start with is to setup accounts for your church on social media platforms. Social media is rapidly becoming the best way for churches to stay connected and reach new people. In fact, 46.1% of churches now say that social media is their most effective method of outreach (Buzzplant). If leveraged correctly, your social media accounts will not only provide a lot of useful information about your church, it can also help you grow and stay connected.

Strategies for growing your church brand on social media

- Post useful resources without promoting the church
- Build content people want to share
- Take advantage of friend to friend connections

One very important feature available on most social media platforms which I strongly encourage you to explore is the livestream feature. This can be used to live stream both audio and video and when used well it leads to greater engagement with your followers in so many ways. For example, it's interactive – a livestream on your Church's page gives members the opportunity to comment, ask questions and play a more active role in real time.

In addition to the above, live streaming opens new channel for collections, donations and giving via a third-party application you can offer online subscriptions for live streamed content or offer the content for free with a request encouraging the viewer to donate or contribute to the collection. So, your tithes, offering and other collections are sorted.

Videos are powerful and I advise you to create more video content as part of your content strategy because people generally respond more to both visual and audio stimulations. There are two major ways you can use video content, first you can live stream your service directly and get people to connect in real time and secondly you can prerecord the service and post or host a watch party on your page (Facebook).

In instances where you are not allowed to have in-person meetings the second option will be the best way out. To do this, you need a pre-recording of your worship service designed especially for online, you can achieve this by asking members of the congregation to record themselves reading certain parts of your worship sessions, and incorporating them into your service so people see lots of familiar faces. Your musicians can creatively record pieces in their homes and the priest or the pastor can as well deliver his/her sermon from wherever he/she maybe. All these video pieces must be woven together by an expert (video editor) for your final broadcast online. The objective is to not try to replicate the in-person experience but to create a completely unique worship experience using digital tools .

Conclusion Remember, churches who will stay connected and pursue their divine mandate in this period of global pandemic are those who do these two things: 1. Use the power of the digital;
2. Follow its rules



SIMPLE WAYS TO GET STARTED

LIVE-STREAMING TO YOUR MEMBERS

Use case 1: Streaming using equipment you already have

The most basic in our list of best live streaming set-ups. With hardware you likely already have—such as a smartphone camera or an integrated webcam on your computer—you can live stream a single video source to Facebook Live or YouTube without additional camera, capture, and encoding equipment. Social streaming using a smartphone is a great mobile option for vloggers on-the-go or for those streaming directly from an event. But while smartphone cameras might offer relatively high-quality sensors, these devices typically lack the extended customizability of professional HD cameras, such as interchangeable lenses, exposure settings etc. Audio quality is generally less than ideal too, especially in situations where the speaker is far away from the smartphone operator or in cases where there is lots of activity in a room or venue (concert, conference, etc). Smartphones also need to be held in the hand, resulting in a less stable viewing experience for your audience.

At this time, only Facebook Live supports mobile live streaming. To broadcast live with a smartphone, you need to download the Facebook app and create a new post using the “Live” option.

Using a webcam on your computer is another low-cost alternative to purchasing an HD camera. However—what you save financially often costs you in terms of image quality, as most (but not all!) webcams capture in lower resolutions.

Webcam placement can also be challenging for professional-quality live streams.

Some integrated webcams on modern laptop computers, for example, are positioned very low within the hardware, resulting in an awkward field of view for your audience.

Note that even with a webcam, you’ll still need encoding software to push your stream to the social platform of choice.

Use case 2: Streaming using a single HD camera (or source)

Streaming using an HD camera is ideal for professional vloggers or video personalities looking to share topical issues, answer questions from fans, or comment on the day’s events. And streaming using an HD camera is an excellent option for content creators looking to deliver the best quality broadcast possible.

There are plenty of different types of HD cameras out there on the market today that are packed with features at increasingly affordable prices. If you don’t currently own a camera, take a look at our list of different types of HD cameras to get a sense of precisely what camera best suits you.

With an HD camera in hand, you need a capture device to capture the camera’s signal (such as AV.io HD) and either a hardware or software encoder to encode and deliver the content to your selected social platform. The easiest way to broadcast your content, however, is to use a designated social streaming device, like Webcaster X2. This device is designed from the ground-up to streamline the social streaming experience for content creators. To describe the process in a nutshell, you simply connect your camera to the device and enter a unique device code into a web field to begin the stream. No capture tools or encoders required.

EQUIPMENT BASICS FOR LIVE STREAMING

Choosing a live streaming computer

While there are ways to stream directly from a camera or capture device, the simplest streaming solutions use a computer as a hub to pull everything together. Whether you prefer a Mac or a PC, make sure you are using a reasonably new machine with a decent amount of processing power and memory. If you would also like to record your streams locally, be sure that you have plenty of hard drive space or an external drive. Once you have a computer selected, you will need to think about installing video production software. Software such as Wirecast and OBS are available for both Mac and PC for live streaming. OBS aka Open Broadcaster Software is completely free and it's a great way to get started. Software such as Wirecast does have an upfront cost, but offers more features that you can work into your productions in the long run

Internet Connection

To send your stream to the streaming platform of your choice, you will need a stable internet connection. While it is possible to stream via WiFi, a hardwired connection is preferred since it is less likely to be interrupted. If at all possible, a dedicated internet connection is even better. This will ensure that you won't lose your connection if a large number of other people decide to use the connection at the same time. If your church is mobile or unable to provide a stable internet connection you can consider a cellular bonding solution

Camera

No matter what type of church you are a part of or what kind of live streaming system you have in mind, you will need at least one camera. That camera will need to be connected to your computer either directly or via a capture device. For the absolute most straightforward way to get started, consider a PTZ (Pan, Tilt, Zoom) camera. USB cameras or webcams are a great place to start, but USB cabling can only be extended roughly 10' without an extension system. Most churches rely on SDI cabling which can be run hundreds of feet without any signal loss. HDMI cabling is also an option but most HDMI cables are only useable up to 35 feet and sometimes 50'.

Not only can a PTZ camera make things simple, but they also have the power and flexibility to capture a professional, high-quality image, consider a PTZOptics USB connected PTZ camera. This camera can connect directly to your PC or MAC and comes in 12X, 20X, and 30X zoom.

That means no matter where you place the camera in the room, you will be able to get a clear image of your worship leaders and the entire room. And because the zoom is true optical zoom, the image will look fabulous no matter the zoom level. PTZ cameras can also pan, zoom, and tilt via remote, giving you total control without actually touching the camera.

Audio Interface

Great looking video is essential, but you can't have a high-quality stream without clear audio. The best solution is to capture sound directly from your soundboard. You can use a simple interface like the Behringer UM2 to feed a signal from the board into your computer. This is great news for your church production team because you can use all of the great audio systems and microphones you already have in place to amplify your pastor and choir. All you really need to do is capture the audio from an output on your audio board and convert that to USB. What you should be looking for is a USB audio interface. This will simply plug into your computer via USB and provide your computer an audio source the same way a webcam would provide your computer with a video source. With an audio and video source into your streaming computer, all you need to configure is your software.

Software for live streaming

The final step is finding the right software for your computer. This software will process your audio and video signals and send them to your streaming providers such as YouTube or Facebook. While there are free options out there, like OBS Studio, you might consider investing a little bit of money on something that will be easier to set up and more intuitive for your volunteers. ECamm Live for Mac or vMix for PC are some great options that won't break your budget.

These are just a few options to help get you started finding the right live stream equipment for church. Your setup may differ depending on your unique needs and budget. However, once you find the right computer, camera, audio interface, and software, it won't be long before your live stream is up and running

USEFUL MINISTRY TIPS DURING COVID



1. Host daily Facebook live, zoom, etc. devotional or Q/A.
2. Small Groups using online platforms to gather for discussion, prayer, bible study, and games (most common were Zoom, Facebook, and Microsoft Teams).
3. Daily newsletter email, video or Zoom meeting; focused on Bible verses, curated articles, or video clips on YouTube of worship or teaching from other sources.
4. "How To" videos (tutorials) for online activities (using Zoom, Facebook live, giving online, accessing streams).
5. Establish specific ministries with volunteers and coordinating leaders focused on delivering meals, supplies, medicine, etc. for those most vulnerable.
6. Coordinated phone calls to every member/attendee; either split up among leadership or assigned to specific volunteers as a new ministry.
7. Use parking lots or drive-in movie theaters to create a "drive-in" experience for services.
8. Draft letters and/or care packages for members' neighbours for them to hand out; focus on introduction, exchange cell numbers, and offer of help/prayer.
9. Create "COVID-19 Kits" filled with toilet paper, hand sanitizer, and dried goods, etc. (cost ~5\$); distributing them in low-income neighbourhoods.
10. Turn the church into a daycare specifically for healthcare and safety workers (done in cooperation with the city in order to comply with "essential" tag).

11. Deliver sanitized iPads to nursing homes quarantined from visitors so they can connect with family and church services.

12. Downscale production value; transform your platform into "living room" to emphasize intimacy of worship and preaching.

13. Provide mobile devices along with directions on how to access the streaming services/apps. For churches without the budget to secure enough devices, members with older devices (phones, tablets, computers) they are no longer using can be donated for this purpose if still in working condition.

14. Launch a website aimed at caring for the of assistance.

15. Introduce a 21-day plan of scripture, group devotions, and worship every day at specific times; designed to help congregants establish a new routine in quarantine around church life.

17. Organize the church into groups of 3 households each; focus on caring for each other and checking in. The purpose is to help with oversight by leaders. Ask the "triads" to do ministry together (participate in Sunday service, witness in their neighborhood, pray together, etc.)

18. Drive-through food pantry; partnered with the town to host supplies.


